70 Arthur Road, Heidelberg	Ament/Burrell House	1865	<p data-bbox="856 306 1136 334"><u>Cultural Heritage Value</u></p> <p data-bbox="856 342 1829 477">The Ament/Burrell House is named after the original holder of the Crown patent, John George Ament Jr. who purchased the property in 1858. He assisted in laying out the settlement of Heidelberg. The property was purchased in 1878 by Johann (John) Hahn. The Hahn family owned the house for approximately 100 years.</p> <p data-bbox="856 521 1818 691">The house is listed in the 1861 census as a 1 1/2 story brick building. Because the current structure is 2 storeys, it must have been built after the 1861 census. The main house is a typical example of Georgian influenced architecture. The smoke house is a particularly excellent example of this type of structure and dates the same period as the main house.</p> <p data-bbox="856 735 1797 906">The front façade has 3-over-3 symmetrical bays. The upper door was once a window, altered when the upper porch was added around the turn of the 20th century. As is common in the Georgian style, the porch wall was plastered, now covered by insulbrick. The house and summer kitchen are constructed of triple brick.
