It has played a prominent role in the community and continues as a branch of the Waterloo Public Library.</p> <p data-bbox="772 545 1839 678">While most institutional architecture at this time displayed Classical and Georgian influence, the school is Victorian in style and solidly vernacular. The building used locally sourced yellow brick and other building materials.
