4260 Hessen Strasse	St. John's Evangelical Lutheran Church	1872	<p data-bbox="772 334 1056 362"><u>Cultural Heritage Value</u></p> <p data-bbox="772 394 1818 496">After the original log church was destroyed by fire in 1870, the new church was constructed in 1872. This church served as a place of worship for the congregation until 1982.</p> <p data-bbox="772 529 1833 712">Designed with a Neo-Classical Revival style, the structure was built with local fieldstone exterior and cut limestone quoins. The structure has plenty of unique elements including an octagonal spire and finial. The church has a large wood door that maintain original locks that are opened by an eight-inch iron key. The church has an engraved dedication stone which reads, "Duetsche ev. Luth./St. Johannes/Kirche/1872".</p> <p data-bbox="772 745 1020 773"><u>Designated Features</u></p> <ul data-bbox="825 805 1839 1130" style="list-style-type: none"> • North, East, and West facades of the building • Roof line of the building gable with soffits and narrow fascia with no return eaves • Bell tower, louvered with tin, octagonal "Swiss/Bavarian" spire and finial • Neo-Classical style, coursed field stone with cut limestone quoins • Windows with six over six panes and mock fanlight (four wedge shaped panes forming semi-circular upper sections) • Arched front door • Keystone of cut limestone • Engraved dedication stone as "Duetsche ev.
