



For the North it was moved by Mose Stever sec. by Isaac Frey that we take this matter to our respective School sections for further consideration. Carried.


For the South it was moved by Alex. Dewar sec. by Adam Hammer that we also take this matter to our respective School Sections for further consideration. Carried.


