<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Flemish bond course used as common bond every sixth course.</li> <li>- brick arches over windows - 1 1/2 bricks high on 1st storey front and on side windows.</li> <li>- brick painted cream</li> <li>- round window above porch distinguishing feature.</li> <li>- porch around door with chamfered columns, half-columns at wall.</li> <li><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> - chimney is a block addition.</li> <li>- frieze with mouldings, brackets under eaves, triangular overhang in return of overhanging eaves.</li> </ul>			
<p>- back kitchen(?) wing + own chimney + chamfered posts on back porch + one storey shed roof - looks original because windows and brick details match those of the house.</p>
