

## ***Descendants of Solomon Stone***

### *Generation No. 1*

1. **Solomon<sup>1</sup> Stone<sup>1</sup>** was born 1790, and died January 08, 1867 in Bond Head Ontario. He married **(1) Esther** 1815 in Vermont USA ?. She was born 1784, and died December 06, 1830 in Bond Head Ontario. He married **(2) Mary Winn** May 11, 1837 in West Gwillimbury, Ontario, daughter of Joshua Winn. She was born 1807, and died September 16, 1882.

Notes for Solomon Stone:

Rev McKillkan and Thomas and Benjamin West were witness to marriage by banns in West Gwillimbury.

Emigrated to Upper Canada from Vermont probably as early as 1823 and appears in an 1837 directory on Lot 4, Con 5 West Gwillimbury Township Ontario.

In an article from the "Families" published by the OGS, states that Solomon Stone sworn allegiance to the British Government and Queen in 1830 along with Thomas West.  
Was a Bible Christian

The Quakers resolved against "the vanity and superstition of creating monuments and entombing the dead with singular notes or marks of distinction, which is but worldly pomp and grandeur, for no encomium nor pompous interment can add worth to the deceased". Therefore, they ordered the erection of tombstones over the graves of Friends be stopped, and the tombstones already so placed to be removed. However, this order was not generally obeyed [Scharf:183].

I also remembered that I had read somewhere that some just used plain "field stones" stood up on end to mark that a grave was there.

Quaker headstones, their removal.

The Yearly national Meeting in 1717 and again 1766 instructed that all headstones be removed from all Quaker burial grounds. Friends were erecting 'vain monuments' over their dead relatives graves. This decision was rescinded later (1850) and simple uniform headstones were used in each area to help relatives find their deceased. Eventually a pattern was agreed, with deceased's name, age and date of death inscribed on a simple locally made stone.

Quakers were unbaptised and were forbidden burial in "consecrated ground" or in church connected graveyards. They buried their dead on private land and would do the same for those forbidden burial in church consecrated land (unbelievers, condemned, suicides etc.).

Be it known that on the thirteenth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty seven, the Last Will and Testament of Solomon Stone, late of the Township of West Gwillimbury, in the County of Simcoe, Yeoman who died on or about the eighth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty seven at the Township of West Gwillimbury in the County of Simcoe, and, who at the time of his death had a fixed place of abode at the said Township of West Gwillimbury in the said County of Simcoe was proved and registered in the said Surrogate Court, a true copy of which said, Last Will and Testament is hereunder written and that the administration of all and singular the personal estate and effects rights and credits of the said, deceased and any way concerning his Will was granted by the aforesaid, Court to Brooks U Howard of the Township of East Gwillimbury in the County of North York, Yeoman and Isaac Grant Stone of the Township of Tecumseh in the County of Simcoe, Yeoman, the executors named in the said, Will. They having been first sworn will and faithfully to administer the same, by paying the just debts of the deceased and the legacies and contained in his Will, so far as he is thereunto bound by laws and to exhibit a true and perfect Inventory of all and singulars the said estate and effects rights and credits and to render a just and true account of their executor ship whenever required by law to do so.

#### Copy of the Last Will and Testament of Solomon Stone

This Instrument witnesseth to, That I Solomon Stone of the Township of West Gwillimbury in the County of Simcoe and Province of Canada, Yeoman being of sound and disposing mind, memory and understanding, do make publish, working and making null and void all former last Will and Testament and writing in the nature of Last Will and Testament by me therefore made.

My Will is first That all funeral charges and just debts shall be paid by my Executors hereinafter named.

The residue of my estate and property, real and personal and mixed of which I shall be seized and possessed, or to which I shall be entitled at the time of deceased, I give, devise and bequeath to my beloved wife Mary (Winn)Stone, the use and interest of fifteen hundred dollars during her natural life; together with the household furniture - at her decease, the said sum of fifteen hundred dollars shall be divided as hereinafter provided-

I give devise and bequeath to my eldest son Abijah Stone. one dollar -  
I give and bequeath to my eldest daughter Lucy Stone , three hundred dollars,  
to my second daughter Mary Stone - four hundred dollars,  
to my second son Isaac Grant Stone, one thousand dollars -  
to my third son Henry Proctor Stone, two hundred dollars,  
to my forth son Benjamin Stone, one hundred dollars,  
to my fifth son Robert Stone one dollar,  
to my third daughter Esther Stone, three hundred dollars,  
to my forth daughter Martha Stone , three hundred dollars,  
to my sixth son George Stone seven hundred dollars.

The amount, the use of which is bequeath to my beloved wife Mary Stone ?, namely fifteen hundred dollars at her decease, shall be divided among my children or their heirs or assigns in proportions to the several sums bequeath, above - I further Will that my estate real and personal be disposed of at my decease to the best advantage and should the amount exceed the several sums bequeathed, then a division shall be made among my several children named above, in proportion to the amount already bequeathed to them, but should it fall short of the amounts specified then a deduction must be made in the same proportions as above excepting my sons Abijah Stone and Robert Stone each of which shall receive but one dollar.

I do hereby constitute and appoint Brookes U Howard of the Township of East Gwillimbury in the County of North York and Province of Canada, Yeoman and Isaac Grant Stone of the Township of Tecumseh in the County of Simcoe and Province of Canada, Yeoman to be Executors to this my Last Will and Testament to have full power to dispose of my lands that I may not have not disposed of also to sign seal and execute all deeds of bargain and sale to any person or persons purchasing also to sign and execute all discharges of Mortgages and other acquaintances in the winding up of my affairs -

In witness whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this ninth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Sixty three.

Thomas West Story

He moved to Vermont in 1786. He was appointed Captain of the Ninth Company, Third Regiment, Second Brigade of the Vermont State Militia, by Governor Tichenor on 19 Jun 1799. He was a farmer. He moved to Ohio about 1808, where he took up land now included in the city of Cincinnati. He moved to Harmony, near Springfield, Ohio, being troubled by the uncertainty of the water level of the fickle river, and there engaged in agricultural and mercantile pursuits. The latter venture involved him in disaster, as he purchased goods in the city of Pittsburgh on the half-credit system. The depreciation of paper money under the old State banking arrangements caused his failure in 1813. About 1821 he moved to Canada where Stephen Howard also from Montpelier VT, had previously moved. He settled at Yonge Street near Newmarket, York County, Ontario, in a settlement of Quakers, of which body his wife Polly was a member, as was Stephen Howard.

He taught school two years and took up 200 acres of the Clergy Reserve or Glebe lands, situated near Bond Head, Simcoe Co., Ont. He afterwards gave it to his son Thomas. Copy of a letter from Thomas West to his son Derrick West:

Notes for Mary Winn:  
Mary Winn was the daughter of the Quaker family of Joshua Winn mother unknown as he married Mary Wakefield who were married March 12, 1807 in Newmarket, Ontario.  
Records of the Yonge Street Quakers in Newmarket are available from the Quaker Archives in Pickering and from the Ontario provincial archives in Toronto.

Joshua, was born in Danby, VT USA March 24, 1787. He died December 17, 1869 in Wellesley twp., ON and was buried at the Yonge Street Quaker meeting house. His wife, Mary, died March 12, 1884 and was buried in the Hawkesville, ON cemetery. I have a wrong birthdate for her of May 1796, but I don't know if part of the date is right, so I have kept it.

Joshua's parents, who are also my husband's ancestors and the ancestors of (US president) Herbert Hoover, were Jacob Winn b. October 31, 1744 in Woburn, Middlesex, MA, d. April 10, 1809 in East Gwillimbury, ON and Phoebe Grout b. April 1, 1751 in Lunenburg, Worcester, MA d. 1819 East Gwillimbury, ON (possibly also buried in the Hawkesville, ON cemetery, but I haven't confirmed this).

Joshua Winn had a sister - Esther Winn who married 1st Nathan Bostwick, he died and she then married William doane and lived in the house on Yonge Street. William gave the property for the Friends Meeting House and the cemetery. Children are: Phoebe, Seneca (who M Elizabeth Webb in 1841 and Anna who married John Rogers 1840.

Esther was the daughter of Jacob and Phebe Grout.

Now It was Timothy Rogers who was sent by England to seek out families to settle along Yonge Street. The idea was to have a road from Toronto up to Lake Simco and they wanted good hard working farmers. Timothy, having lived in Danby, Vt. knew of the Quakers and it was approved. He sent for all the Quakers to come from Vermont and Penn. and they settled in Newmarket - were given land to clear, but had to clear the road first and after their farm was settled, they got the Patent.

It was MacKenzie who stirred up the people and he left for USA while he was being sought. Then that fellow was hung and that did it for the Winn family and many others who moved to Hawkesville to farm.

**3. Abijah Howard<sup>2</sup> Stone** (Solomon<sup>1</sup>) was born November 02, 1817 in Quebec, and died May 24, 1896 in Hawkesville. He married **Mary Landerkin** February 23, 1843 in West Gwillimbury, Ontario, daughter of James Landerkin and Elizabeth Fenton. She was born February 23, 1819 in Nova Scotia, and died August 15, 1899 in Hawkesville.

STONE ABIJAH, (d), late of Wellesley, was b in Simcoe County 1818 and died at the age of 78. He was of English descent and owned a small farm in Gwillimbury. With a large family to provide for, it became necessary to look for wider field of labor; accordingly in 1848 he purchased 285 acres in Wellesley Township and 115 in Peel. The land at that time was worth \$500 per lot and is now valued at \$28,000. Mr Stone was always active in every work that pertained to the welfare of his Neighbours, and his country. He was one of the pioneers whose name is worthy of a place with the nations builders of Canada. He took a great interest in church affairs, and was Stewart and Trustee of the Meth church for many years. In political views he was a Liberal. He M. Mary Landerkin who d. at the age of 80.

(I have a record of his birth as 13 Mar 1875 in Hawksville, Wellesley Twsp,) Margaret's husband James Henry Stone is the father. Actually Isabella was sick in a hospital in Kitchener continuously from the time that Thomas was born and she died about a year later. (I suppose that's one of the reasons that Thomas was raised by his grandparents.

The parents of Margaret and Isabella, (there were 10 children altogether) were George Ruler and Elizabeth Wright who were married about 1846. (They are both buried in Hawksville Ontario cemetery along with quite a few other Rulers of the same immediate family.

George Ruler was a brother, (or perhaps 1/2 brother), to William George Ruller (2 LL's) who is my direct ancestor and my GG Grandfather

The whole family Group that came to Canada from Yorkshire England in 1842 were, Isabella Ruler, (The mother of four illegitimate Ruller/Ruler children.) (No fathers were listed in their birth records I Yorkshire, and her 4 children (1) William George Ruller and his wife Eliza Holgate and their daughter Ann Ruller, (2) George Ruller (3) Thomas Ruler and (4) daughter Annie Ruller.

In all the Yorkshire records that I have seen, the name was always spelled with one "L" Ruler. Once they got to Canada, William George's family and descendents have always been spelled with 2 "LL"s.

In the 1851 census for Wellesley Township you will find all the Rulers and Rullers, Also Montezuma Brothers and his new bride of that year Hannah Cunningham, George Ruler had married Elizabeth Wright by then and their were lots of Cunninghams, Stones, and Wrights etc.

I was fortunate to be able to visit the Township offices for Wellesley several times and had free access to all their Birth, marriage and death records for Wellesley Twsp.. I made quite a few photo copies from the original records. The rest I got through correspondence with a Mildred Guy of Clearwater Manitoba for a few years and got most of the information about all of the descendents of George Ruler and Elizabeth Wright from her. (Apparently quite a few of the family moved to that area around 1900.) An excerpt from a letter she wrote me on January 6, 1982 she says, "Mildred Guy gave me pretty well all of the descendents from George on down, I'm not sure if they're all in my current version of Family Tree maker, but a lot of them are. If you can tell me how to get this information to you, you're welcome to it.
