FATHER NOTES: Paul Urban Moser

R3 Note: Paul and Catherine emigrated to New York Sep 17, 1836 on the Sagimore with their three sons, John, Michael, Charles. They had in their possession 3.000 gulden which translates into \$94,000 Canadian dollars in 2019. Paul's son Francis came later around 1855 with his wife Elizabeth and their 11 children. According to the Gore District assessment and census records in 1838 he was living at #12 Bechtels Tract. By 1840 Paul had 100 acres uncultivated and 5 1/2 acres cultivated and lived in a frame house. The property had a value of £61. In 1838 there were only 4019 persons living in all of Waterloo Township. By 1851 the census listed Paul as a gentleman. Paul and Catherine were living with Charles and Maria on Petersburg Rd in 1851, Lot 35.

MOTHER NOTES: Catherine Bender

General: We do not have a correct date of death for Catherine. Her stone says April 22, 1885, age 88; not possible

CHILD NOTES: Francis Anton Moser

General: farm labourer; death certificate says he died of cholera morbus one hour duration

CHILD NOTES: John Philippe Moser

General: farmed at crossroads in Bamberg

CHILD NOTES: Charles Philippe (Carl) Moser

R3 Note: The 1851 census shows Charles and Maria living in Waterloo Township with his parents Paul and Katherine Moser and their own children Katherine, Regina, and John. On March 7, 1848 Charles received his naturalization papers to become a Canadian citizen. He purchased his 120 acres of land, two roods and three perches on the Petersburg Road, lot 35 of the German Company Tract, Waterloo Township on Oct 25, 1849 from Peter Erb and John Brubacher for £150. This is where four generations of the family farmed. The original log house was moved in time near the Elmdale School according to Eileen Moser Futher. For many years the Kitchener Silo Co. was located on the homestead property across from what is now the Super Centre Shopping Plaza on Highland Rd. W. Kitchener. Charles and family are buried in Mount Hope Cemetery, Kitchener close to the road near the Sacred Heart School. It is an impressive red coloured stone near where the Wilhems are also buried. There is a Grandma Catherine also mentioned on the stone who died at age 83 years. Charles left a will making Wm. Fischer and Edward Halter his executors. He had goods and inventory valued at \$2866 which he distributed evenly amongst his four children

CHILD NOTES: Michael Francis Moser

R3 Note: He farmed on Hesson Rd. Wellesley Twp. lot 9 con 6. Francis wife Marie was a Mennonite. He is buried in St Johns Lutheran Ce. on Hesson Rd. near his farm.
